

FAMILY BIBLE CAMP — 2008

INFORMATION FORM

DATES: June 30-July 4, 2008. Check-in will be from 10:00 A.M. to Noon on Monday, June 30. Departure will be at 11:00 A.M. on Friday, July 4.

THEME: “THE WONDROUS CROSS”

PURPOSE: The purpose of this camp is to worship the Lord, study His Word, and enjoy Christian fellowship together. Our desire is that each camper may grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We expect everyone to dress and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner.

AGES: We have separate classes for the following age groups: Preschoolers (up through age 5), Pre-juniors (ages 6-8), Juniors (ages 9-12), Seniors (ages 13-college age), and Adults. Preschoolers and Pre-juniors must have a parent or guardian staying with them at camp and be responsible for them at all times.

COST: The fee is \$75.00 per camper with a maximum of \$200.00 per family (i.e. immediate family of parents and children). There is no fee charged for preschoolers (up through age 5). As always, remember that **no one is turned away for lack of the fee.**

REGISTRATION: If you would like to attend, fill out the registration form (both sides) attached to this sheet, detach it, and mail it to: **Family Bible Camp, 1450 Oak Hill Road, Fort Worth, TX 76112.** Please fill out a separate form for each camper. Keep the information sheet and rules sheet. A separate *Camp Arrowhead Release Form* **must also be signed** by each camper (or parent).

WHAT TO BRING: Bible, pencil, notebook, comfortable but modest clothes (see rules inside for details), sheets, a blanket, pillow, towels, wash rags, toiletries, flashlight, camera, insect repellent, and musical instruments. If you are staying in a motel room you **do need** to bring sheets and towels this year (double bed and twin bed sheets).

LOCATION: Camp Arrowhead, 5236 N FM 199, Cleburne Texas 76033. From Cleburne take I-67 South toward Glen Rose (about 13 miles). Turn right on FM 199 (you can see the canoe shops on the right). Follow 199 to the T, and turn left. Go 3 miles; the camp will be on the right. Camp Phone #: (254) 897-2323.

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CAMP RULES

1. Camp Arrowhead is a Christian campground and all rules are to help us in our conduct to reflect Christ in all that we do. All campers and sponsors must know and follow these rules.
2. Please respect all camp properties. We ask you to assist in keeping the grounds clean of trash. Cans are provided camp wide to dispose of debris.
3. The following items are **not permitted** at camp: pets, illegal drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, guns, knives, fireworks, matches, TVs, radios, CD or tape players (unless used by program personnel), video games, secular books or magazines, water guns, water balloons, or anything deemed detrimental to the intended atmosphere. Such items will be confiscated by camp staff and then returned at departure.
4. Cell phones, pagers, and beepers should be used for emergency purposes only.
5. Campers must attend all scheduled sessions and activities during the week unless they are ill or are accompanied by a sponsor.
6. Campers may not leave the camp grounds unless the camp director is notified. Campers may not drive or ride in a car during the week of camp.
7. The Brazos River is not approved for swimming or other water activities. Keep a safe distance from the water at all times.
8. Campers are not allowed to enter the dorms of campers of the opposite sex.
9. Clothing Rules:
 - Shorts are permitted, but must be fingertip length.
 - All T-shirts, caps, etc. which advertise alcohol or tobacco products or are of a suggestive nature may not be worn.
 - No spaghetti straps will be allowed. Shirts must exceed the waist band of pants, shorts, or skirts.
 - Girl's swimwear must be one-piece and modest or a dark colored T-shirt must be worn over it. Boys are to wear modest trunk-type suits. The lifeguard may eject anyone wearing swimwear that is not in good taste. The lifeguard must be obeyed at all times. A cover-up must be worn going to and from the pool.
10. Public or private displays of affection (including holding hands) will not be tolerated, nor will cursing, threatening, or fighting.
11. No shaving cream or water fights are allowed unless approved by a camp director.
12. No use of the ropes course will be allowed unless your group directors have arranged its use and unless authorized and trained Camp Arrowhead staff are present.
13. No camper may share ANY medication with another camper. All medications (prescription and nonprescription) must be checked in with the camp nurse upon arrival or left with a parent or guardian who is staying in a motel room.
