In 1961, when United Nations Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjöld died in a plane crash, documents found in his apartment revealed his “negotiations with myself - and with God.” They were published in a book titled *Markings*.

One topic Hammarskjöld pondered was why his loneliness ran so deep and was so persistent. He asked God, “Didst Thou give me this inescapable loneliness so that it would be easier for me to give Thee all?”

A hint of how Hammarskjöld handled the situation is found in this prayer he wrote:

Give me a pure heart that I may see thee,
 A humble heart that I may hear thee,
 A heart of love that I may serve thee,
 A heart of faith that I may abide in thee.

Like the food supply of an army, prayer simultaneously feeds the individual Christian’s spiritual growth and the church’s effectiveness in mission. If prayer is not emphasized, both starve. -Herb Miller
