

Centennial Charge Conference, January 24, 2016

Called to order by Superintendent Weesner at 11:35 am.

First business was to elect/appoint a secretary. Verna Bowie was the secretary for this conference.

Superintendent Weesner explained what our vote would indicate. A “yes” vote meant a committee would complete research on project to include dollar amount, who would be doing what, how it would be done when and bring that information back for one more vote in a third charge conference. A “no” vote would indicate all are not comfortable with parts of the project and the project canceled.

Chairperson Gaylen Heaberlin presented the informative slide show including dates, a little past history, and the areas the committee would continue to work on the project to move to Phase 3.

A question/answer period followed with more than ten questions asked and answered.

Superintendent Weesner offered a prayer. Ballots were distributed to members of Centennial congregation. A ballot count committee was formed and the vote count determined. Superintendent Weesner notified the congregation that the vote results were: No-34, Yes-28. He indicated that Centennial does not now have a plan at this time and there will not be a Phase 3 Conference. Superintendent Weesner closed the conference with a prayer at 12:20.
