### Lord’s Day Worship

The “communion of saints,” an article of faith that we affirm when we recite the creed, is fundamental to the teaching of Christianity. From the beginning of the Church, the gathering together of the family of God has been considered vital to the life of the believer. Scripture clearly indicates that the Church is a body of believers.

After His resurrection, the risen Christ met with the disciples as a group at various times to teach them the scriptural meaning of His resurrection, to break bread with them, to bless them, and to urge them to proclaim the gospel to the world.

Following Pentecost, the believers continued to assemble together. The gatherings included fellowship, singing, prayer, communion, the expounding of the Scriptures, and a collection. From these meetings they went out to proclaim the good news to the world.


Hebrews 10:24-25 mandates corporate worship. Attending church on Sunday brings many spiritual blessings, provides a clear public statement of support for God’s work, is an indication of our love for our Christian family, and demonstrates our commitment to the Christian walk.

In each part of our Sunday observance - in praise, thanksgiving, prayer, quarterly communion, and hearing of the Word - we are instructed to be “of one accord.” Our spirits meet and blend in worship and He is in the midst.

There is a clear distinction between private devotions and corporate worship, and both are necessary to the healthy spiritual life of the believer.
