"REFLECTIONS on the TORCH"

The torch made its 70 day journey winding through tiny villages & metropolitan cities throughout Great Britain before lighting the cauldron in London during Open Ceremonies. Then the world was united by that flame for 16 days in August as Olympians provided breath-taking moments of agility, strength and endurance. As I reflect on what I witnessed this past month, the greatest remaining impact for me has been the testimonies of sacrifice from various athletes:

- The fourteen year old gymnast, "Flying Squirrel," who left her family and endured extreme homesickness for two years, so that she might train under the best coach
- The runner who did not eat even one dessert for 2 years in a commitment to consume only healthy foods
- The swimmer who had not watched TV in 3 years in order to devote every possible moment to training And on and on the stories went. It wasn't luck that got them to Great Britain. It was a commitment to unrelenting improvement, resolve in the face of ease, a willingness to receive constant critique, and the determination to begin again in the face of setbacks.

That's a perspective I desire for myself, our pastors, and the people in our churches - to live a life of faith with determination and joy, realizing that daily we are on the world-stage, representing God's Kingdom. I pray that we will . . .

- serve our God with all that is within us heart, soul, mind and strength
- refuel on God's Word daily, and rest our bodies & souls regularly
- avoid choices, attitudes, pettiness, or actions which could distract or disqualify us from our goal
- welcome critique, and ask others to coach us, in order to become more than we currently are
- commit to a team a small group or ministry partners for mutual support & encouragement

It is true that in the spiritual realm, only the Spirit of God can provide transformation and fruit. But that recognition needs to be paired with the additional truth that as God's representatives, we are responsible to always be IN TRAINING. Too many times, I think we settle for simply **TRYING at the last moment,** rather than **TRAINING over the long-haul.**

I read an article recently by Joni Eareckson Tada – a woman who became paralyzed from the neck down 47 yrs. ago in a diving accident. From her motorized wheelchair she made the following comments: "I want to give this life all I've got and FIGHT FOR GOD now, because this is the only chance I get to fight. Once I get to heaven, I'll be in CELEBRATION mode."

May the heart of an athlete beat within each one of us. May we desire to FIGHT FOR GOD daily, running with endurance our race, carrying the torch of His light and love with us as we go to work, to school, and into our neighborhoods, so that we might be His light-bearers, igniting hope in others wherever we go.
